SHOW RULES, PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

The Show is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all. A copy of these rules is obtainable from the GCCF, 5 King's Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgwater, Somerset TA6 4AG, price £1.50, and must be read by all for they are not repeated herein but will be strictly applied. Ignorance of any Rule will not be accepted as excuse of its breach.

REGISTRATION

All Cats, Kittens and Neuters must be registered with the GCCF. To be effective for entry all registrations and/or transfers must have reached the GCCF Office 21 days prior to the Show. Household Pets are unregistered cats of unregistered or unknown parents; no registered cat may enter classes offered for them.

SHOW ENTRY FORM

Exhibitors are responsible for the correct description of their cats and for entering them in the correct classes when completing their entry form for the Show. Exhibitors should read the declaration and must sign it. If the exhibit belongs to more than one person, each person must sign the entry form and all must be members of the various clubs to compete for the trophies that are offered. No Kitten can be entered in Adult Classes unless stated for 'Adult or Kitten'.

Please remember to enclose an open stamped addressed envelope (not postcard!) with your entry. A copy of your entry as it will appear in the catalogue will be sent back to you for checking.

VETTING-IN

The exhibits will be received at the Show Hall from 8.00 am to 9.45 am on Saturday, 10th January 2009. There will be NO overnight penning. All exhibits must be brought to the Show in boxes, baskets or suitable containers (top-opening recommended) and must be accompanied by their owner or representative.

Each exhibit will be examined on arrival by the Clubs' Honorary Veterinary Surgeons. No exhibit may be penned before examination by them. Vetting-in slips will be given out on the day of the Show.

All cats exhibited at Shows held under GCCF Rules must have a current vaccination certificate against FIE, FVR and FCV ('cat flu'). The full course, in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations, must have been completed more than seven days before the Show. The vaccination certification must be issued by a veterinary practice/hospital and the last vaccination signed by a veterinary surgeon or by a listed veterinary nurse under the direction of a veterinary surgeon. The certificate must be available for inspection at vetting-in. Cats without acceptable certificates might be rejected. Cats showing a positive reaction to the Feline Leukaemia Virus or Feline Immunodeficiency Virus blood tests must not be shown. Please note that, for the purposes of vetting-in, homeopathic vaccinations are not acceptable to the GCCF.

Exhibits must have clean ears and coats free from pests. Any exhibit rejected by the veterinary surgeon must be removed by its owner(s) and entry fees are forfeit. There will be quarantine pens for those cats rejected but owners are advised to take home any unfit cat.

If, in the opinion of the veterinary surgeon, it is desirable, all other exhibits from the same cattery and their owners shall be debarred from the Show. The veterinary surgeon's decision is final.

Any exhibit which shows the effect of drugs e.g. stress remedies such as Skullcap and Valerian, including sedatives for travelling, will be considered unfit for exhibition and will lead to disqualification.

PENNING OF EXHIBITS

Every competitive exhibit must be provided with a white sanitary tray and clean plain white or near-white blanket or blankets without distinctive marking or edging which may be arranged in such a manner as to assist the comfort of the cat. Cellular blankets are not allowed but white Vetbed or like material may be used if preferred. A hot water bottle or heat-reflecting material may be used but must be concealed with a blanket. All exhibits must have water but food containers MUST be removed when judging starts at 10.00 am and may not be returned until 12.30 pm. Judges are instructed to pass any pen that is distinguished in any way.

The use of grooming aids in the Show Hall, other than the use of a clean brush and comb or cloth, is prohibited. No powder or grooming substances may be left in the coat of exhibits. The use of shampoos that may change the colour of a cat's coat can lead to disqualification.

Other than official notices or award cards, no written or printed matter may be placed on competitive pens. Exhibition pens only (unless otherwise stated) may be decorated and may carry printed matter relating to the exhibit. Exhibits actually received at the Show Hall cannot be removed without the sanction of the Show Manager. They are only received on condition that the Club shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits, boxes or baskets, or in any other way. Exhibitors should check their pens for security before penning their cats.

WITHDRAWAL FROM CAT SHOWS - NEW GCCF RULING

The last date for withdrawal of a cat from a show is the advertised closing date for entries at that show, after this date the cat concerned may not be withdrawn from the catalogue of the show and the 13-day rule about entering two shows within 13 days will apply. Show Managers may be prepared to return part entry fees if the cat is not present at the show but the entry in the catalogue must not be withdrawn. This ruling does not prevent Show Managers from returning entries after the closing date of the show if they are unable to accept them into the show because the show is full.

Entry fees will be refunded for entries withdrawn before the publishing closing date. Thereafter a percentage of the entry fee may be refunded at the discretion of the Show Manager. Withdrawal of entry must be in writing. If the entry is withdrawn on veterinary advice, a proportion of the entry fee may be returned at the discretion of the Show Manager providing that a Veterinary Certificate is received by the Show Manager seven days prior to the date of the show.

The Show closes at 5.00 pm. No cat may be removed from its pen before this time. There will be no early passes. No-one may remove any exhibit from its pen except the owner or a Club Official. Penalty for contravention of this Rule is £10.

COUNTERSIGNING OF CERTIFICATES

In the event of a change of judge of an Open Class occurring after the closing date of the show, and provided that the exhibitor informs the Show Manager prior to judging that a Certificate has previously been awarded by the replacement judge, the Show Manager shall appoint one other judge who shall judge the cat and, if the cat is considered worthy, countersign the Certificate which shall then count towards championship status. If the replacement judge at the first show has also been previously booked for a subsequent show, the closing date of which is before the date of the first show, then at the subsequent show this judge can be considered as a replacement judge for the purpose of requesting a countersignature.

RULE ON CONDITION

Any cat or kitten disqualified by a veterinary surgeon or judge on grounds on condition must be reported by the Show Manager to the Secretary of the GCCF.

NEW RULE ON BITING AT SHOWS

Any cat biting or inflicting injury by deliberately scratching a judge, veterinary surgeon, steward or other show official must be reported to the Show Manager. The Show Manager must withdraw the cat from the show and shall inform the owner of the cat in writing, sending a copy to the Secretary of the GCCF. If the cat was defending itself in exceptional and frightening circumstances that information should be given to the Secretary of the GCCF for consideration by the Executive Committee. If the cat is reported at any subsequent show, it shall be disqualified from all future shows unless the Executive Committee rule otherwise.

The clipping of the tips of show cats' claws is considered desirable.

VETERINARY CLEARANCE CERTIFICATES

Exhibitors whose cats have been rejected at shows should note the following points:

- (1) When sending your clearance certification to the Veterinary Officer please include your copy of the rejection slip.
- (2) Please do not send these certificates by recorded delivery as this can cause considerable delays in the receipt of your certificates. If you wish to satisfy yourself that your letter has reached the Veterinary Officer please enclose a stamped, addressed postcard for acknowledgement of receipt, and this will be signed and returned to you.
- (3) Exhibitions should not attend shows until they have received a letter from the Secretary of the GCCF confirming clearance. It is recommended that this letter be taken to shows within a month of the issue of the clearance letter.

JUDGES

Judges are empowered to withhold any prize or championship in any class if the exhibits do not, in their opinion, possess sufficient merit. Prizes will be awarded from judges' award slips not from catalogues or award cards.

THE COMMITTEE RESERVE TO THEMSELVES THE RIGHT TO:

- (a) appoint other judges should those advertised be unable to fulfil their engagement and appoint further judges if deemed necessary;
- (b) fix and limit the number of exhibits at the Show and to accept or refuse entries without giving any reason;
- (c) cancel, amalgamate or divide classes;
- (d) publish a catalogue of the Show containing information as to exhibits and names and addresses of the exhibitors.

CORRESPONDENCE

All correspondence must be accompanied by a stamped addressed envelope. Any complaint related to the Show must be forwarded to the Show Manager in writing within seven (7) days of the Show.

CHAMPIONS AND PREMIERS

The title of Champion for Cats and Premier for Neuters shall be granted to exhibits winning three Challenge/Premier Certificates at three shows under separate judges. A GCCF Challenge/Premier Certificate will be offered for each Cat/Neuter Open Class of recognised breeds with championship status.

CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS AND PREMIER OF PREMIERS

The title of Grand Champion shall be granted to a Cat winning three Grand Challenge Certificates at three shows under separate judges. To compete in a Champion of Champions Class, a cat must be a full Champion. Only one prize, with a Reserve in case of disqualification, will be granted. A Champion cat may be entered in its ordinary Open Class and in the Champion of Champions Class. The title of Grand Premier shall be granted to Neuters under the same rules and conditions as those for Grand Champion.

IMPERIAL GRAND CHAMPIONS AND IMPERIAL GRAND PREMIERS

The title of Imperial Grand Champion will be granted to a Cat winning five Imperial Grand Challenge Certificates at five shows under five different judges. To compete in the Imperial Grand Champion Class, a cat must be a full Grand Champion on the date that the show closes. A Grand Champion cat may be shown in any TWO of the following classes: Imperial Grand Champion, Grand Champion, Open Class. The title of Imperial Grand Premier shall be granted to neutered cats under the same rules and conditions as those for Imperial Grand Champion. The Imperial Grand classes will be split into male and female.

SPECIAL ADVICE TO EXHIBITORS

- (a) In the event of a cat being unable to attend due to illness, provided a vet's certificate is received by the Show Manager at least seven days before the Show, a refund may be made at the Show Manager's discretion.
- (b) You are advised against purchasing any shampoos that change a cat's colour as this can lead to disqualification.
- (c) Homeopathic vaccinations are not acceptable to the GCCF for the purpose of vetting-in.

- (d) Any alteration to your entry form must be in writing which will be attached to the form by the Show Manager. You may also make corrections to the form up to the close of the Show.
- (e) Kittens under 14 calendar weeks may not be shown.
- (f) Any person whose cats have been rejected under Sections C or D must not officiate as a judge or steward or in any other capacity which requires the handling of cats at shows until a clearance certificate, as required by the GCCF, has been obtained.
- (g) The use of small battery-driven fans in pens can be dangerous and could also be considered a distinguishing mark.
- (h) Please note that in addition to the classes you have entered your cat may also be handled for the purposes of assessing candidates in the GCCF Appointment Scheme.
- (i) Queens who have kitted within 12 weeks of the date of the show may not be shown.

DEFINITIONS

Adult	Not less than 9 calendar months on the day of the Show.
Kitten	Not less than 14 weeks and under 9 calendar months on the day of the Show. Note that neutered kittens must be entered in Kitten Open, Miscellaneous and Club classes.
Neuter	Neutered male or spayed female cat.
Breeders	For cats and kittens bred by exhibitor.
Debutante	For cats and kittens never exhibited before at a show under GCCF rules (at time of entry).
Novice	For cats and kittens which have not won a first prize at a show under GCCF rules (at time of entry).
Limit	For cats and kittens that have not won more than four first prizes (at time of entry).
Radius	For exhibitors from within a 30-mile radius of Show Hall.
Visitors	For exhibitors from outside a 30-mile radius of Show Hall.
Aristocrat	For cats with one or more CC or PC but not full Champions or Premiers (at time of entry).
Socialite	For cats with one or more Merit (at the time of entry).
Adolescent	For cats between 9 months and 15 months on the day of the Show.
Junior	For cats under 2 years old on the day of the Show.
Senior	For cats 2 years or over on the day of the show.

Wins as kittens do **not** count when entering adult classes. Wins as entire cats do **not** count when entering neuter classes.

AC - Any Colour, AOC - Any Other Colour, AV - Any Variety, C - Cat, F - Female, GCCF - Governing Council of the Cat Fancy, K - Kitten, LH - Long Haired, M - Male, N - Neuter, SH - Short Haired.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Executive Committee of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy reminds all cat owners of the dangers of using disinfectants based on Phenol and Cresol. These substances are highly poisonous to all cats. Exhibitors at shows should not use such disinfectants for cleaning pens or take them into the Show Hall. Aerosol and other sprays must **not** be used in the Show Hall.

NON-PEDIGREE SECTION



All Cats and Kittens entered for this section must be **unregistered** and **non-pedigree** and, if known, must be of **unregistered** and **non-pedigree** parentage unless entered in the special classes provided. All cats over nine months must be neutered.

No one shall exhibit:

- (a) a cat or kitten which, at the date of the show, has to his or her knowledge been exposed to an infectious or contagious disease within the previous **three** months;
- (b) a cat which is in kitten;
- (c) a cat which is nursing young kittens.

It is important to make sure that your cat's ears are really clean inside and that there are no fleas in the fur otherwise the vet may disqualify and there is no refund of any entry fees.

Vetting-in cards will be issued at the door on the day of the show.

Cats and kittens should be in a suitable container, **not on a lead**. They will be received at the Show Hall between 8.00 am and 9.30 am and **must** be examined there by the Clubs' Honorary Veterinary Surgeons before penning. Any cat which, in the opinion of the vet, is unfit for exhibition will be returned to the owner to be taken home and all entry fees will be forfeited. The vet's decision is final.

Each cat must be provided with a plain white blanket(s) or white Vetbed (not cellular type), a white sanitary tray and white water bowl. Cats must be penned before 10.00 am when judging commences. Exhibitors must withdraw whilst judging is in progress but they may return at 12.30 pm to feed their pets. All objects, except litter trays and water bowls, must be removed from pens before 10.00 am.

Owners must, under no circumstances, speak to a judge whilst judging is in progress.

Cats must remain in their pens until 5.00 pm.

The GCCF rules that no exhibit may be shown twice within a period of 13 days.

All cats exhibited at Shows held under GCCF Rules must have a current vaccination certificate against FIE, FVR and FCV ('cat flu'). The full course, in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations, must have been completed more than seven days before the Show. The vaccination certification must be issued by a veterinary practice/hospital and the last vaccination signed by a veterinary surgeon or by a listed veterinary nurse under the direction of a veterinary surgeon. The certificate must be available for inspection at vetting-in. Cats without acceptable certificates might be rejected. Cats showing a positive reaction to the Feline Leukaemia Virus or Feline Immunodeficiency Virus blood tests must not be shown. Please note that, for the purposes of vetting-in, homeopathic vaccinations are not acceptable to the GCCF.

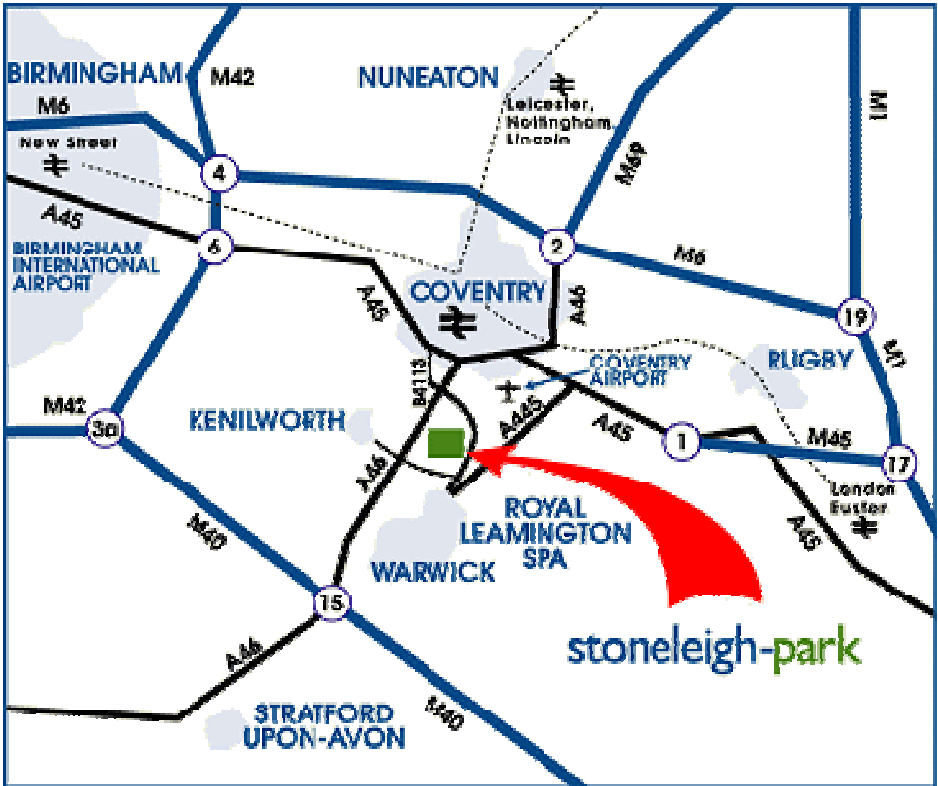
